INDIVIDUAL RACE RESPONSIBILITIES

Race promoters do not have to recognize special class divisions. We will supply an entry template for individual race promoters to offer at each race (that will record divisional information per competitor). Simply scan or take a photo of that sheet and send it to ironpawfactory@gmail.com after the race. The I.P. US-CAN-NA Dryland Series crew will be responsible for tracking series points and awarding Championship Certificates. No extra funds need to be collected or sent in. Awards will include electronic certificates and Championship merchandise that Champions can purchase at a nominal fee.

PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Participants from each race will automatically collect points for the series.

Points will be earned each day. Top 6 points per driver per class will determine Championship final results. There are 5 races in the series or 10 chances (days) to earn points. If a driver participated in more than 6 days of racing, only their top 6 scores will be counted for the Championship (the lower scores will be thrown out). **EXCEPTION IS 6-DOG RIG** where top 4 scores will count, as only Seeley Lake and Dirt Ronyd support the 6-Dog Rig Class.

A Championship Series tie breaker will go to the Driver with the most wins (throughout the series). In the unlikely event there is a number of wins tie, the Series Championship will be awarded to the Driver who won the last race where both competitors were racing head-to-head.
